Lost Horse Press and the Northwest Fair Trade Network host a Fall Festival of Fair Trade, happening Friday, Oct. 31st, from 10 a.m. until 6 p.m., and Saturday, Nov. 1st, from 9 a.m. until 3 p.m. at Sandpoint Community Hall. The festival is a market for fair trade goods from around the world—fair trade is a growing movement that promotes alternative approaches to conventional international trade. The Fall Festival of Fair Trade will feature fairly traded goods—sweaters, textiles, clothing, baskets, tea and coffee, jewelry, leather goods, books, pottery, handmade paper, toys, musical instruments and a diversity of exotic gifts— from Mexico, Africa, Guatemala, Chile, Ghana, Thailand, Burma, Nepal, Tibet and Laos, as well as a selection of handmade goods by local artists and craftspeople. Admission is free.
