Lost Horse Press and the Northwest Fair Trade Network host a Fall Festival of Fair Trade, happening Friday, Oct. 31st, from 10 a.m. until 6 p.m., and Saturday, Nov. 1st, from 9 a.m. until 3 p.m. at Sandpoint Community Hall. The festival is a market for fair trade goods from around the world—fair trade is a growing movement that promotes alternative approaches to conventional international trade. The Fall Festival of Fair Trade will feature fairly traded goods- sweaters, textiles, clothing, baskets, tea and coffee, jewelry, leather goods, books, pottery, handmade paper, toys, musical instruments

and a diversity of exotic gifts— from Mexico, Africa, Guatemala, Chile, Ghana, Thailand, Burma, Nepal, Tibet and Laos, as well as a selection of handmade goods by local artists and craftspeople. Admission is free.
